- 5.6 At Bury TR to cross the ford
- 5.8 TL Sign Post (SP) Skilgate
- **7.5** TL SP Upton
- **8.0** TL SP Haddon Hill. Parking and toilets.

A myriad of short walks with good views of lake, Brompton Regis, & Exmoor ponies Return to road and TL

- 9.8 At Bridge End TL, SP Brompton Regis
- **10.0** Straight on SP No Through Road (optional detour to church remains)
- 10.9 End of road, remains of St James Church, Upton. Turn round and return to main road
- 11.7 TL, SP Brompton Regis
- 12.8 TL, SP Brompton Regis
- 13.1 TL, SP Brompton Regis
- 13.2 TL, SP No Through Road
