Exe Valley Caravan Site

Walk No. 1 West Howe Hill 3½ miles: 2 hours

Steep up hill stretch for 500 yards, but the rest is easy walking with a grand view of Winsford

Turn right from the campsite entrance, and after crossing the bridge, right again to follow the bridleway to Coppleham with views of the campsite and the weir across the river. At the end of the field pass through a gate with blue 'way' marks and continue along a track to the road where you turn right.

- 150 yards on road, then turn left on to the drive by the 'footpath/bridleway' sign.
- 50 yards branch right following 'footpath to Winsford' to follow the yellow 'way' marks.
- 50 yards go through the gate (**Don't** turn left: **don't** go to the house)
- 30 yards over style, and continue uphill between fence and hedge.
- 150 yards over style at top.100 yards take middle gate going straight ahead with hedge on right.
- 150 yards straight on through gate 'footpath'

Follow track in the gully with views of Winsford, hedge on your right down to corner of field.

(Gate in corner on right would take you to Howetown & Winsford)

Turn left for route back to campsite via Coppleham Cross, now following the blue 'way' marks.

100 yards through metal gate. 100 yards through gate into woods.

200 yards with river down below, then through gate and branch right 'bridleway'

100 yards through gate and follow river on your right.

Through another gate and with fence on your left to small hunting gate with blue 'way' marks.

Through gate, bear right and continue to follow bridleway with fence and then hedges on your right

At field corner follow track up between gorse slightly left. Don't go to gates by the river.

Through iron gate and the next 2 gates to junction with 'bridleway' sign. Good view Exton Church R Take right fork downhill and follow bridleway back to the drive at Coppleham cross the 1st drive.

Turn right at the 2nd drive and retrace your earlier steps back to the campsite.
